## TEC workplan 2016-2018: TNA

- Activity 9.1 - In collaboration with the AC, the LEG and the CTCN, consider how Parties could be helped to align their TNAs with the process to formulate and implement national adaptation plans.
  
- The secretariat has organized a telephone conference on 26 April with members of the TEC TNA task force, the AC, the LEG and the CTCN to discuss possible outcomes, to consider how this work could help Parties, and possible deliverables of this work.
  
- The secretariat has organized a meeting in Bonn on 15 May, during SB-46, with members of the TEC TNA task force, the AC, the LEG and the CTCN, to discuss elements of the draft paper on aligning TNA and NAP processes.
  
- The TNA task force in collaboration with other three bodies developed a draft paper on Aligning TNA process with NAP process, as jointly developed by the AC, the LEG, the CTCN and the TEC.

## TEC workplan 2016-2018: TNA

- Activity 9.2 – Analyze linkages between TNA process and NDC process
- TEC TNA task force produced an updated paper on linking TNA and NDCs process, taking into account the latest development of the NDC and TNA process.
- The updated paper provides an analysis of NDCs and TNAs, which includes more than 70 NDCs from a variety of countries, at different stages as it relates to the TNA process, taking into account the implementation potential of the both processes.

## TEC workplan 2016-2018: TNA

- Activity 11 - Prepare a draft methodology on how to monitor the TNA results, including what such monitoring should include, with a view to showcasing success stories.
  
- TEC TNA task force tested the proposed option of the monitoring process from the background note “Draft methodology on monitoring and evaluation of the implementation of technology needs assessment results” presented at the TEC-14 meeting, in a selected number of countries in African region.
  
- The secretariat organized the testing at the TNA training workshop "Moving from Technology Needs to Implementation of Technology Actions" jointly with the UNEP DTU Partnership (UDP) on 27 June 2017 in conjunction with the Africa Carbon Forum 2017 in Cotonou, Benin.
  
- The TNA task force has drafted TAP monitoring guidance with a view to be embedded into the TEC guidance for preparing a TAP.
