1. Mandate

2014. SBI invited TEC to evaluate PSP with aim of enhancing effectiveness of Technology Mechanism

2015. TEC evaluated PSP and submitted final report to SBI (FCCC/SBI/2015/16). SBI invited key stakeholders to act upon TEC recommendations in report. TEC noted that climate tech centres and pilot projects were in early stages of implementation and that it was therefore difficult to measure impact

2015. SBI thus invited TEC to update its evaluation report and submit it to SBI in November 2017. Invited TEC to update report drawing on mid-term evaluation reports of:

- Climate technology transfer and finance centres
- Pilot projects from GEF fourth replenishment period

2016. SBI noted that it looked forward to TEC updated evaluation report



2. Possible process for evaluation

- Consider terms of reference (next slide)
- Mandate TEC task force to undertake inter-sessional work
- Invite GEF to provide inputs
- Finalize evaluation report at TEC 15
- Submit report in September 2017 to SBI 47 (November 2017)

- GEF Poznan strategic programme aims to promote investment in technology transfer, to help developing countries address their climate tech needs
- TEC evaluated the programme and submitted report to SBI in 2015
- SBI invited the TEC to update its evaluation and submit report to SBI in 2017, focusing on climate tech centres and pilot projects
- TEC 14 to decide on process for undertaking the update evaluation
