Background

- The offset platform (aka the online platform for voluntary cancellation of certified emission reductions) was launched on 15 September 2015
 - Basic design
 - Basic capabilities
- EB 93, February 2017, mandated improving the design of the user interface and adding capabilities, based on an external review by an e-commerce expert
- Version 02.0 was released on Friday, 24th August 2018, just ahead of EB
 100

- New content about:
 - The purpose and positioning of the platform
 - Offsetting and the CDM process

- New integrated calculator for annual household emissions *

Budget and timelines

- Version 2: costs accommodated by MAP 2017 and MAP 2018
- Actual costs:
 - \$ 58 K for web-design
 - \$ 120 K development and implementation


- No fixed timeline due to 2-phase approach (scheduling development dependent on completing the web-design)
- Project completed in 18 months release date 24th August 2018



Post release work

- Spanish version was released in March 2019
- Automation of the approval process
- Notification process and streamlining of the bank transfer payment










