Global DNA Forum Meeting

- After 2 years of virtual meetings, DNAs met in a physical setting in Dubai, exchanged views with the Vice-Chair of the Board, and provided input to the Board;
- Guiding questions for the session were:
 - How could the CDM Executive Board further support CDM stakeholders under the temporary measure?
 - How could the Board further increase the use of pre-2021 certified emission reductions (CERs)?
 - How could further knowledge sharing among DNAs be facilitated?



Co-chairs' take-away from the meeting

- DNAs remain engaged in emission reduction activities to address climate change and are eager for clarity on the process for transition of activities to Article 6.4 mechanism and use of CERs for 1st NDC or updated NDC;
- DNAs are eager to have capacity-building and opportunity for knowledge sharing among DNAs under Article 6 through RCCs;
- DNAs are grateful for the opportunity the Forum provided – thanks to the Board for its continued support to DNAs;
- Elections of the new Co-Chairs and Alternate Members for the DNA Forum Chairing Committee 2022 took place.



Co-chairs' take-away from the meeting...Contd.

DNAs discussed:

- Handling of new cases being received from project developers;
- Role of DNA under temporary measures, transition to Article 6.4 mechanism and use of CERs towards 1st NDC or updated NDC;
- Possible use of CDM methodologies in Article 6.2 activities.



Suggestions to the Board

- The Board may:
 - Provide flyer, podcast or information on the UNFCCC CDM website on temporary measures for project developer';
 - Provide standard information to DNAs to respond to project developers' queries on temporary measures;
 - Further promote voluntary cancellation to increase the use of pre-2021 CERs;
 - Conduct capacity-building events for DNAs, through RCCs, to ensure CDM transition into the Paris Agreement to raise investor confidence in opportunities in Article 6;
 - Continue to conduct regional and global
 DNA forum meetings as they proved to useful to discuss concerns, share experience and provide feedback to the Board.
